

Pursuant to Article 13 of the EU's Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) "GDPR", we inform you that:

1. the controller of your personal data is the Maritime University of Szczecin, with its seat at 1-2 Waly Chrobrego street, 70-500 Szczecin, Poland, tel. (+48) 91 48 09 400, email: pm@pm.szczecin.pl
2. contact details of the Data Protection Officer: iod@pm.szczecin.pl
3. your personal data will be processed for the purpose of carrying out the university admissions procedure. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR and in the case of specific data (concerning health) Article 9(2)(b) of the GDPR – fulfilling of the legal obligation of the Controller, resulting mainly from the Polish act Law on Higher Education and Science. The provision of personal data is a legal requirement. The processing of personal data beyond the personal data necessary for purposes arising from the university admissions procedure, requires your consent. The provision of personal data is voluntary and the basis for its processing is Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR;
4. we may disclose your personal data to the authorities or other public entities that have statutory right to access such information pursuant to binding provision of the law as well as to entities involved in data processing on our behalf on the basis of data processing agreements. Your personal data shall not be transferred to third countries;
5. your data shall not be used for automated decision making purposes, including profiling as referred to in Article 22 of the GDPR;
6. in the event of non-admission, we will store your personal data for the period necessary to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected, i.e. to carry out university admissions, for a maximum of 1 year after the final conclusion of the appeal proceedings concerning the admission process. In the case of enrolment, for the duration of the course of study and thereafter the data will be archived and kept for 50 years. In the case of personal data processed on the basis of your voluntary consent, we will keep the data until you revoke your consent;
7. you have the right to:
 - access to the personal data concerning you pursuant to Article 15 of the GDPR;
 - rectify your personal data pursuant to Article 16 of the GDPR;
 - request erasure of your personal data in the cases referred to in Article 17 GDPR;
 - request, pursuant to Article 18 GDPR, the controller to restrict the processing of your personal data, subject to the cases referred to in Article 18(2) GDPR;
 - the portability of personal data in the cases referred to in Article 20 GDPR;
 - object to the processing of personal data in the cases referred to in Article 21 GDPR;
 - withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time. Withdrawal of your consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.you can make use of these rights by submitting a written request to the Data Protection Inspector at the address of the controller to "Data Protection Inspector" or to iod@pm.szczecin.pl;
8. furthermore you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority i.e. the President of the Data Protection Office if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provision of the GDPR.
